Dear East Noble Students and Parents:

This year we will be offering a trip to Gettysburg and Washington, D.C. for seventh and eighth grade students. Classic Tours of Auburn will be making the arrangements for us. This is an East Noble school board approved trip and all school rules and regulations will apply. It will be chaperoned by teachers and other adults as needed.

We will depart from East Noble Middle School the evening of Friday, March 19, via motor coach. We will travel to Washington by way of Gettysburg and arrive at our hotel on Saturday evening. We will leave Washington the evening of Tuesday, March 23, and arrive back at East Noble Middle School early the next morning, Wednesday, March 24.

Our meals will be at large food courts(\$15 allowance) and buffet style restaurants. You will be responsible for lunch and dinner on Saturday. All other meals are included.

The student cost is \$1,181.00 per student and includes transportation, accommodations for three nights (quad occupancy), ten meals, sightseeing and admissions, evening activities and accident insurance (\$2500.00). This price is based on a minimum of 35 participants per motor coach. If the number signed up for the trip falls below the minimum, an adjustment will have to be made in the trip cost or in the trip itself.

Highlights of our trip will include a tour of the Gettysburg battlefield; a tour of the Capitol building; a night tour of the memorials; visits to Arlington National Cemetery and Mount Vernon in Virginia; a dinner/dance cruise on the Potomac; several hours in the Smithsonian Institute museum complex and much more.

We are confident that a visit to Gettysburg and Washington, D.C. will provide a unique learning experience, as well as a valuable insight into our nation's history and government. If you have questions not answered by this letter please feel free to contact us at school.

Behavior Contract for Trip to Washington D.C.

From March 19-24, 2027, East Noble Middle School is taking some 7th & 8th Grade Students on a field trip to Washington, D.C. Though the students are taking this trip during their spring break and will not be "in school," all East Noble District and East Noble Middle School Policies and Regulations will be in effect. This trip requires that students behave in a manner that reflects honorably on the community and school district that they represent. Students are expected to follow all rules and policies to ensure the safety of everyone for the duration of the trip.

I agree to abide by all District and School Policies leading up to and while in attendance on the trip to Washington D.C. In addition to the District and School Policies, I understand that I must also abide by the following trip regulations:

- 1) I understand that any suspension from school that involves but not limited to; drugs, alcohol or weapons may disqualify me from participation in the class trip (this includes suspensions occurring prior to signing this contract).
- 2) Occurrences of OSS/ISS/RFC in excess of 5 days **during the 2026-27 school year** may prohibit a student from attending the trip.
- 3) I understand that referrals received after signing this contract for behavior that could jeopardize the health, welfare, and safety of other students, may result in my immediate suspension from the class trip. Referrals of this nature may include but are not limited to:
 - ☐. Fighting/inappropriate physical contact with another student
 - ☐. Harassment or bullying
 - ☐. Insubordination
- 4) I understand that District and School rules apply on this trip. If I engage in any behavior deemed to be a violation of the ENMS Student Code of Conduct while on this trip (including while traveling on the bus to Washington D.C), I may be subject to disciplinary actions enforce by the chaperones and trip coordinator, including removal from the trip and being sent home via airline at the expense of the parent(s).
- 5) I understand that, while on the trip, school administrators and or chaperones may search my personal belongings with just cause and will confiscate any illegal or banned items as described in the Code of Conduct or at law. If I am found in possession of any illegal or banned items while on the trip, I may be suspended from the trip and may face further disciplinary action in accordance with the District's Code of Conduct.
- 6) I must adhere to the strict timeline for reporting to chaperones including the nightly curfew. If I do not report to my chaperone on time or if I break curfew, I understand that I may face disciplinary action.
- 7) I understand that the East Noble Middle School Dress Code will be in effect for the duration of the trip.
- 8) I understand that electronic devices, including cell phones, may only be used in designated areas and at designated times, and students must comply with all regulations of the sites visited regarding their use. Chaperones are not responsible for the care of personal student devices.

Disciplinary Procedure:

The behavior contract signed by each participating student and his/her parent/guardian is binding. If a student violates this behavior contract, ENMS and trip coordinators reserve the right to impose any of the following sanctions:

1) Violation of the behavior contract prior to trip departure: Violation of the behavior contract prior to departure will result in the immediate forfeiture of the student to attend and enjoy the privilege of the trip. Monetary refunds will be granted according to the policy of our tour company, Classic Tours Inc. There is a possibility that a refund will not be given if the terms of this contract are violated. Students that have received a suspension or removal from class in excess of 5 days will not be eligible to attend the trip.

2) Violation of the behavior contract while on the trip: Violation of the behavior contract while on the trip may result in one or all of the following consequences depending on the severity of the infraction.

☐ One on One Chaperone: If a student is unable to behave in an age-appropriate manner, the student will have to be accompanied at all times with their chaperone for the duration of the trip or until a head chaperone deems it acceptable to allow the student to engage in the full benefits of the trip. Unacceptable behavior may include but is not limited to pushing, shoving, tripping, practical jokes, cursing, talking at inappropriate times in locations that require silence, insubordination, etc.

☐ Parental Pick-up: If a student engages in conduct on the trip that, in the sole discretion of any chaperone, warrants expulsion from the trip, a student's parents may be called. A parent would then be responsible for driving to Washington, D.C. to retrieve, or transport of their child home via airline at their sole cost and expense.
